Presenting:

Stefan Salmonson (Keynote) is President of PROtective Services and a national speaker. He is a licensed deputy sheriff, licensed private detective and protective agent, certified personal protection specialist, international security consultant, and an airline transport pilot. He provides executive and personal protection services, high risk employment termination support, discreet investigations, security presentations, training, consulting and assessment for over 600 clients across the United States.

Joe Grafft is President of Customized Safety Training, LLC, providing Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Law Enforcement training/education. He was a former EMS Manager with the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and an EMS Manager for Metropolitan State College, EMS Specialist with the State Board of Technical Colleges, Director of EMS for District Memorial Hospital, and Director of EMS Education and Ambulance Services with Independent School District #16.

Tony Rose is a United States Marshal appointed by George W. Bush in 2002. He spent 4 years in the U.S. Coast Guard and was an employee of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. He was a member of the FBI National Academy 162nd Class. He is a retired chief (16 years) of the Rawlins, Wyoming Police Department, past President of the WY Sheriff's and Chief's Association, State Representative (WY — four terms), and Chairman of the Judiciary Committee.

Tracy Worsley is the System Emergency Preparedness Manager with the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities. He is a certified Emergency Manager (20 years of active duty in the U.S. Air Force, 12 years as a Security Police Specialist in nuclear security and air base defense). Tracy has trained in disaster preparedness including nuclear, biological, chemical and conventional defense, major accident and disaster response. He served in several combat theaters – responsible for physical security and responding to ground attack and recovery of air operations. He was a certified instructor in Military Technology and Disaster Preparedness and consultant for Homeland Security on numerous pandemic and school crisis exercises for the Department of Health in Clay County.
